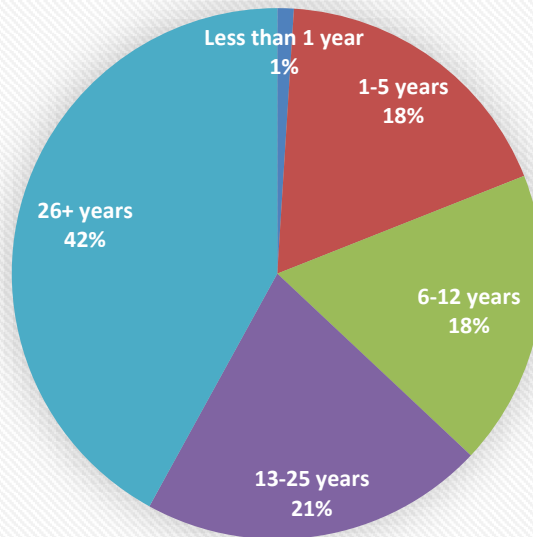

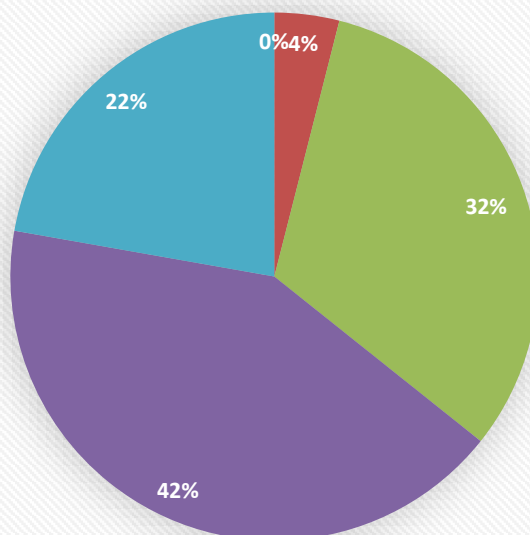

Q1ii - Length of residence

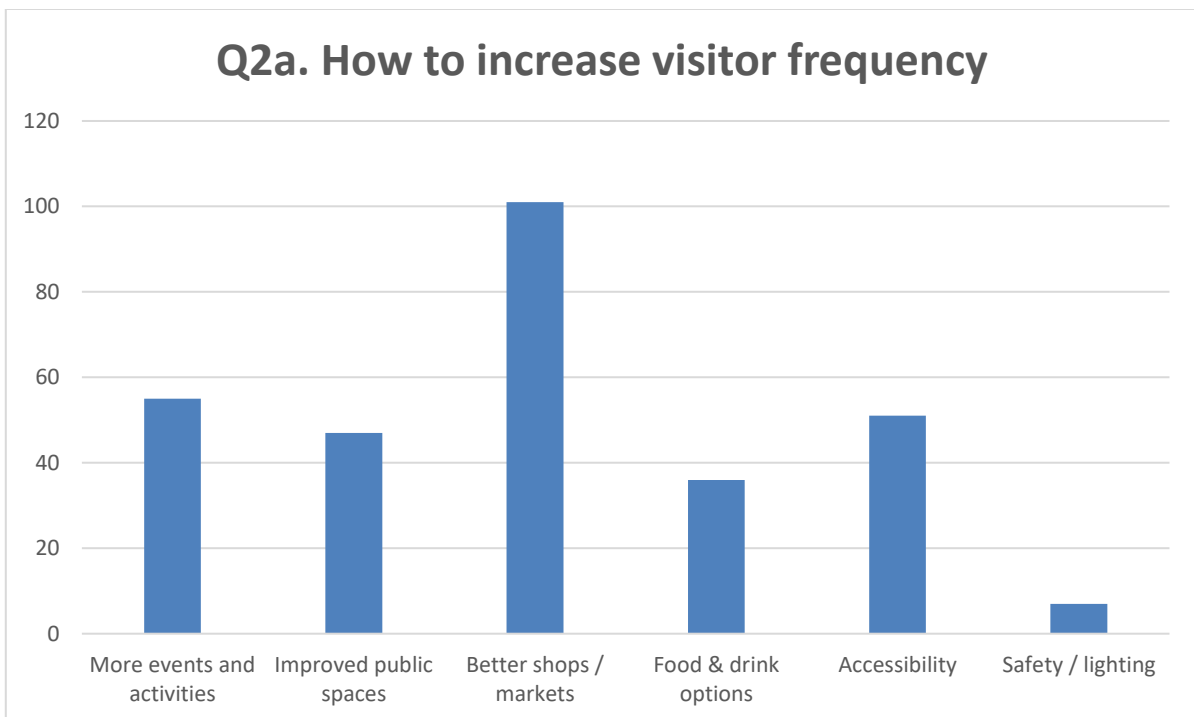
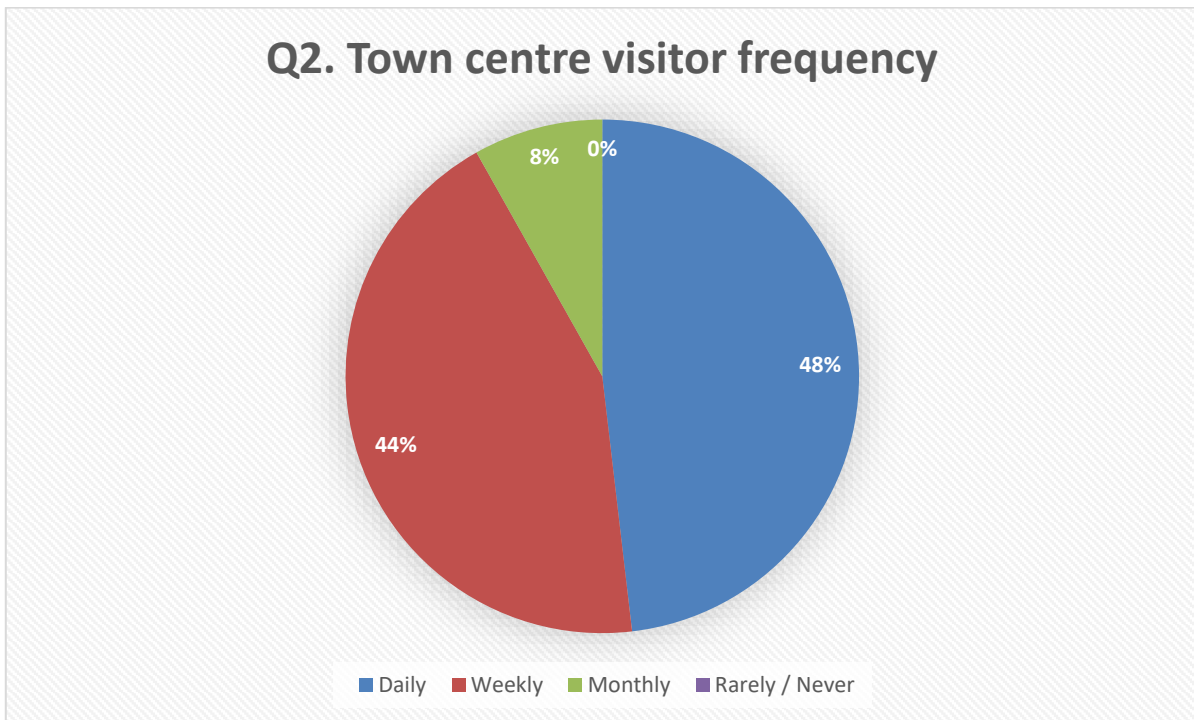


■ Less than 1 year ■ 1-5 years ■ 6-12 years ■ 13-25 years ■ 26+ years

■ Under 18 ■ 18-30 ■ 31-50 ■ 51-70 ■ 71+

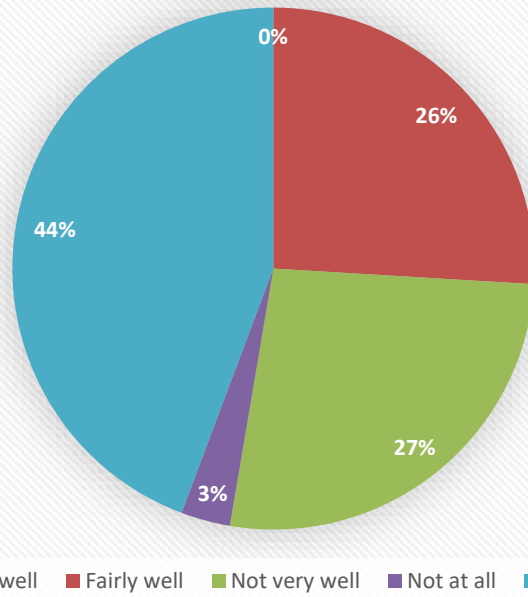


Q2b Summary - What is one change that would make the biggest difference to you?

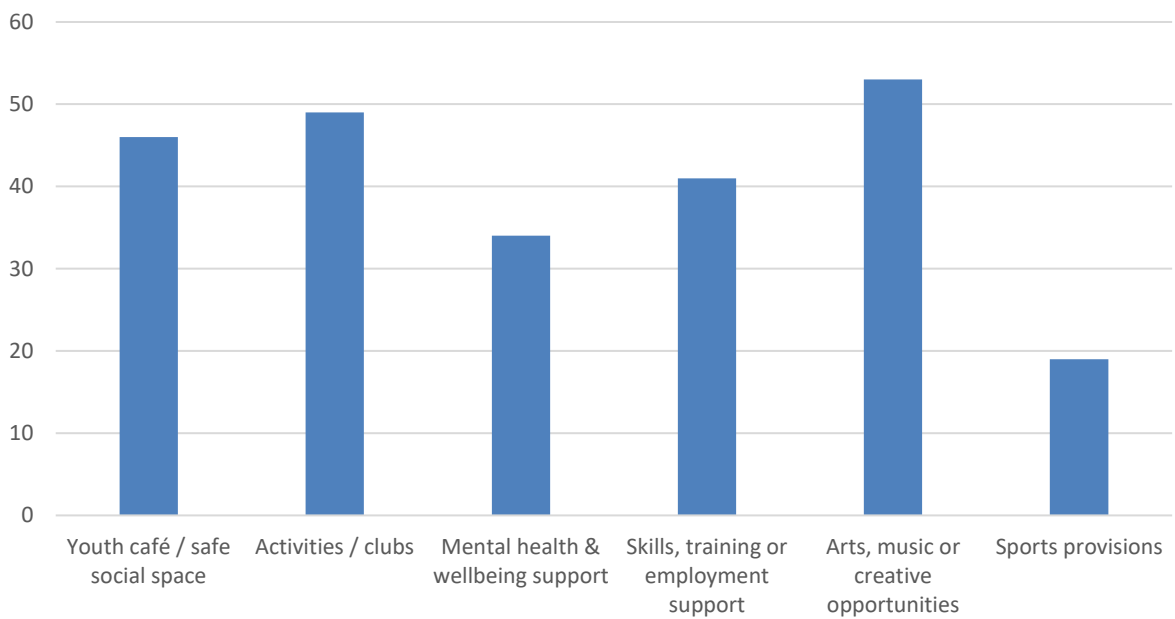
Residents most frequently wanted:

- **Better accessibility and seating areas**

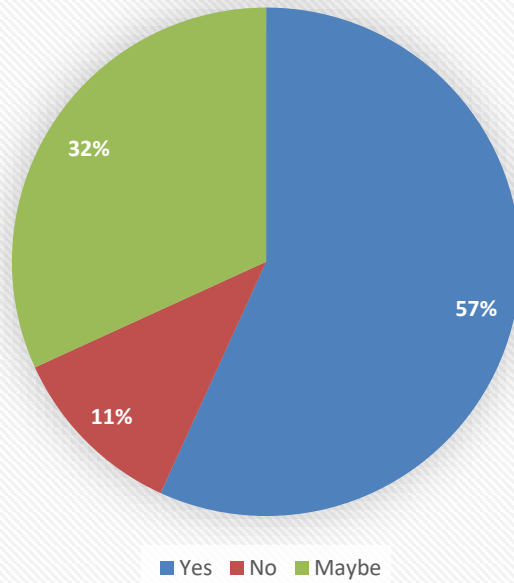
Q3. Youth support rating



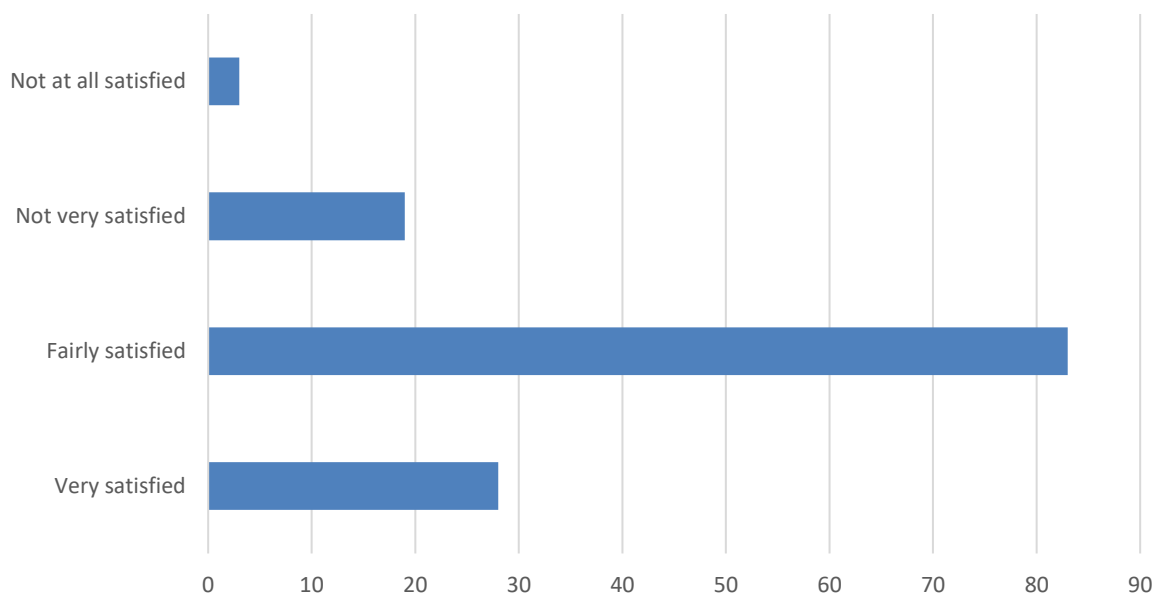
Q3a. Youth - what should be developed?



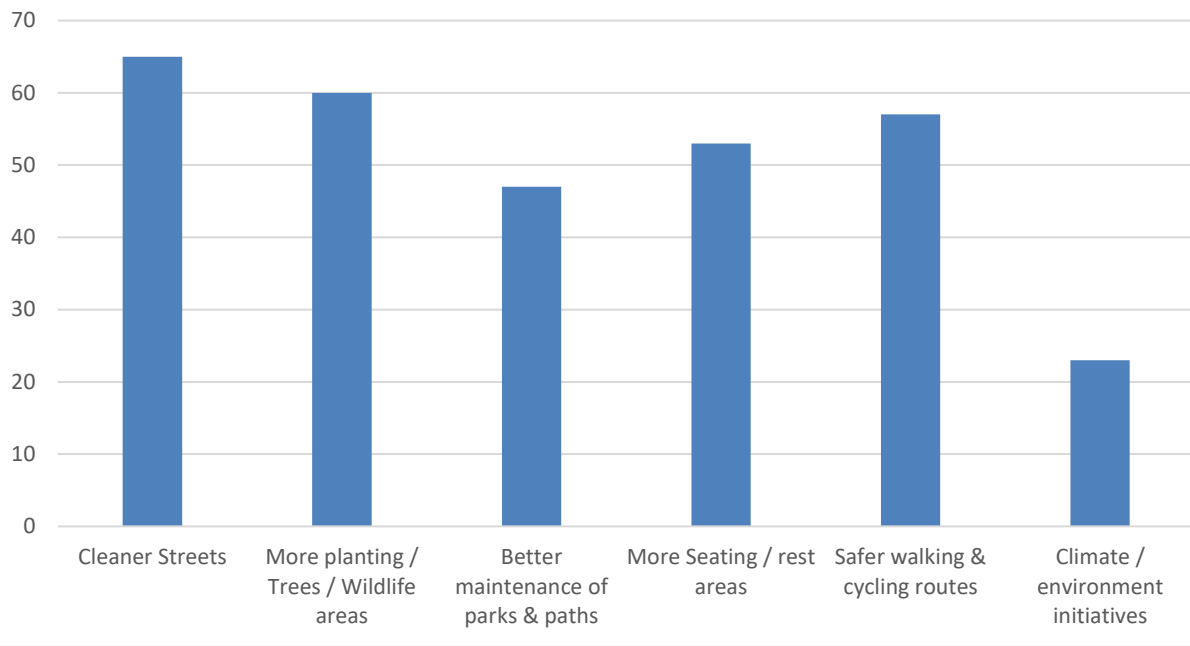
Q3b. Would you use this service?



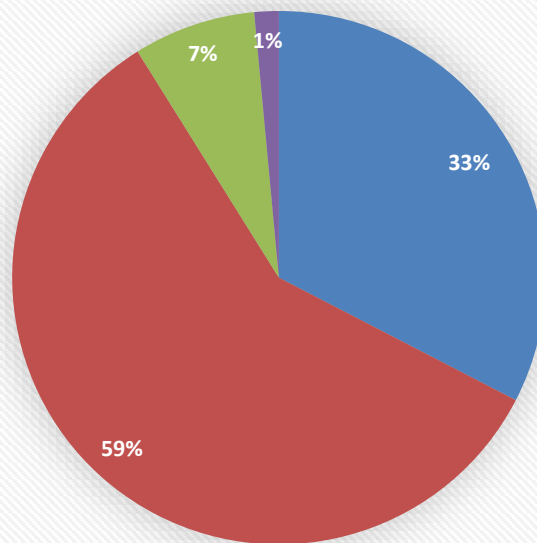
Q4. Public space satisfaction



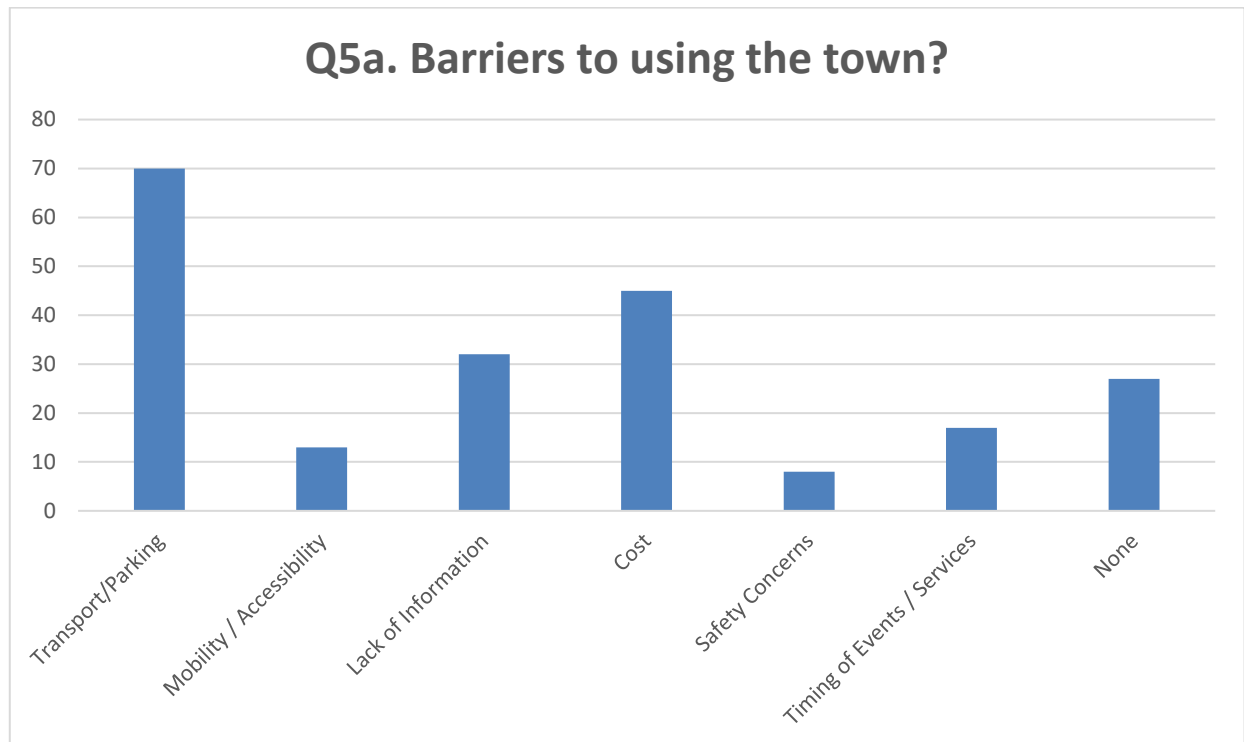
Q4a. Which improvements matter most?
