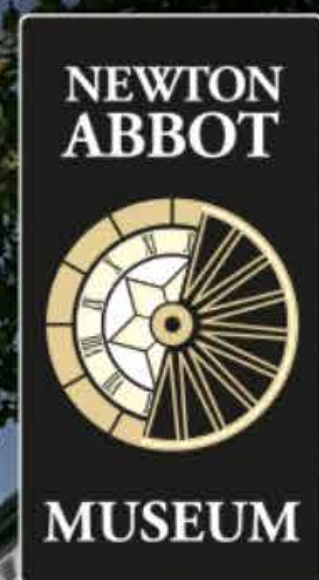




Celebrating summer at the museum and beyond
