


Love upcycling? Check out the unique treasures to be discovered in our excellent charity shops.






## Cycling





# A rich heritage, a bright future

## We have a long history...

Neolithic flint tools have been found at Berry's Wood above the River Lemon where an Iron Age fort – one of two in Newton Abbot - is located.

The Romans later made use of this second one at Milber Down and then, some thousand years after that, a Norman castle was erected at Highweek.

A Royal Charter was granted in 1220 and the twin towns of Newton Abbot and Newton Bushel – one either side of the River Lemon – began to develop their long histories of trading until formally uniting in 1901.

Our oldest property is Bradley Manor, a medieval home now cared for by the National Trust and open to visitors for booked tours.

Historic Forde House was constructed in 1610, shaped as a letter 'E' in honour of Queen

Elizabeth who had just died. For details of tours and events visit www.museum-newtonabbot.org. uk.

In 1688 Prince William of Orange was declared King in Wolborough Street, next to our landmark St Leonard's Tower which is itself an historic jewel and open to the public. Admission is free, visit www.newtonabbot-tc.gov.uk for opening times. The Newfoundland fishing trade of the 17th and 18th centuries created good opportunities for Newton Abbot, as did the leather industry and clay extraction.

The coming of the railway in the 19th century transformed the town and for centuries livestock has been bought and sold in the town centre.

Dartmoor granite, used in the construction of many famous landmarks including the London Bridge now in Arizona, was once carried along the Stover Canal before being shipped at Teignmouth.

Today Newton Abbot is a regional centre for employment and shopping – and much more besides.






Newton's Place - a stunning free museum and community space

The western part of Newton Abbot's town centre is developing as our Cultural Quarter, being home to Newton's Place, St Leonard's Tower, the Library and Golden Lion Square.

# Our Cultural Quarter



## Newton's Place - a stunning free museum and community space

A glance at the exterior and it's clear that the building was once a church.

But by the 1980s the congregation was dwindling and eventually services stopped.

The Grade II listed Victorian structure became an antiques centre, then developers tried to convert it into a nightclub!

In 2016 Newton Abbot Town Council stepped in and set about creating a fantastic new facility with significant help from the Heritage Lottery Fund. Museum entry is free and there are frequent exhibitions and events including live music.

## St Leonard's Tower

St Leonard's Chapel was built in the 13th century by the wealthy Abbots of Torre.

It stood at the heart of old Newton Abbot, where markets first made an appearance following the granting of Royal Charters in the 1200s.

Fast forward to the 1800s and officials planned to demolish the crumbling building but townsfolk objected and the tower was saved - it now features on our official town logo.

The location of where the nave once stood is marked on the ground, look out for the pavement inserts. Today the tower opens to the public on occasions and is the focal point for many of our celebrations such as crowning of the Carnival Queen, Christmas lights switch-on and Mayor's carol service.

## William of Orange

In 1688 William, Prince of Orange, sailed from Holland to Brixham, with London his ultimate destination. Two days later he reached Newton Abbot and, at the market cross next to St Leonard's Chapel, declared his intention to become King of England – the so-called Glorious Revolution to restore a Protestant monarch.

The bells of St Leonard's were rung in celebration and today the commemoration monument still remains.

## Our Library and Railway Studies Collection

The Railway Studies Collection is one of the country's largest sources of historic rail-related information boasting more than 80,000 photos and publications.

It attracts countless enthusiasts and there is a calendar of regular talks and events.

The collection is housed in the Passmore Edwards building, a strikingly handsome Victorian landmark which also hosts our town library complete with its own café.


The MacKrell Almshouses in Wolborough Street aren't open to the public but certainly worth a look at while heading towards Bakers Park. Built in the 1870s by benefactor Thomas MacKrell, he had intended them for 'decayed' tradespeople of the town. They still provide sheltered accommodation today.

In East Street keep an eye out to the left as you head towards the railway station. You might spot The Rope Walk signwritten above two ordinary looking doors. Behind them was once a 140-yard long manufacturing facility in which ropes were made for the centuries-old Newfoundland fishing trade.

The War Memorial at the junction of Queen Street and The Avenue features a bronze figure of Freedom, placed triumphantly on top of a tall stone column and holding the broken chains of bondage.

It was unveiled in 1922 and bears the names of all townsfolk lost in combat since the First World War.

More insights into Newton Abbot's rich past are revealed in the Town Trail series, available from the museum in Newton's Place, Wolborough Street.



# Bradley Woods where town meets country


## Bradley Woods is a special place...

Look up from the clear waters of the picturesque River Lemon and all around the valley is swathed in beautiful native woodland.

There's history too.

A steep and rugged path on the southern side of the river leads to Puritan's Pit, also known as The Devil's Pit.

This rocky chasm was once a 17th century



outlawed place of worship.

It is thought to have been created by the collapse of a limestone cavern and human occupation of the area dates to the Stone Age.

Look out also for remains of 'the witch's house', a large property which burned down in mysterious circumstances a century ago.

On the other side of the river is Berry's Wood Iron Age hillfort and below it Bradley Manor.

Now cared for by the National Trust, Bradley Manor is Newton Abbot's oldest dwelling with 13th century origins.

Visit the National Trust website to book a guided tour.

You will also spot what appears to be a pretty stream running slightly above the river.

This is in fact a leat, a manmade watercourse which once fed the town's many mills.

Walk through Bradley Woods to the fields beyond and find footpaths and lanes to explore further using OS Map OL 44.
